Thank you for contacting our Department regarding the proposed *Remedial Actions at 100-H-54 Project* on the Hanford Site, Benton County, Washington.

We do not concur with the Determination of No Historic Properties Affected.

As you know BPA has identified Traditional Cultural Properties on the Hanford Site that are currently being reviewed by the National Park Service and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation.

We believe further consultations are necessary given the ongoing Section 304 case from BPA.
