This letter transmits the approved 100-BC-5 Operable Unit Sampling and Analysis Plan, DOE/RL-2003-38, Revision 2, to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for information.

This sampling and analysis plan (SAP) has been updated to reflect completion of remedial investigation (RI) sampling by removing sampling requirements associated with the RI that are no longer needed. The SAP will be revisited, and revised as necessary, once a remedial decision has been made, as part of implementation of the Record of Decision.

The U.S. Department of Energy Richland Operations Office and contractor staff have worked closely with Laura Buelow of your staff using the data quality objectives process to develop and reach agreement on this update.
