GROUNDWATER SAMPLING AND ANALYSIS PLAN FOR THE 200-BP-5
GROUNDWATER OPERABLE UNIT, DOE/RL-2014-33, DRAFT A

This letter transmits the Groundwater Sampling and Analysis Plan (SAP) for the 200-BP-5 Groundwater Operable Unit, DOE/RL-2014-33, Draft A to the Washington State Department of Ecology for review and comment. To assist in the review, the U.S. Department of Energy Richland Operations Office and its contractor are available to meet with your staff to discuss the SAP.

This SAP presents the groundwater monitoring program for the 200-BP-5 Operable Unit. The 200-BP-5 Operable Unit recently completed the remedial investigation (RI) phase of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) process and an RI report is being prepared. The monitoring program defined in this plan supports the post-RI period and will be used to direct CERCLA routine groundwater monitoring activities until a remedial action decision is made for the Operable Unit.
