**CONSULTATION FOR THE UPCOMING 100-F AND 100-IU-2/6 CLEANUP DECISION**

The U.S. Department of Energy Richland Operations Office (RL) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) are planning a cleanup decision for the 100-F and 100-IU-2/6 Areas of the Hanford Site in accordance with the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act. Tribal consultation and staff involvement are important to the cleanup decision-making process.

RL and EPA anticipate the Proposed Plan for 100-F and 100-IU-2/6 Areas will be available for comment in the March/April 2014 timeframe. RL and EPA staff have been involved with Tribal staff through ongoing venues for information exchange and dialogue. In addition to those, and in recognition of the importance of the 100-F and 100-IU-2/6 Record of Decision RL and EPA anticipate issuing later this year, we invite formal consultation with your Tribal elected leadership.
