### 3.3 WASTE MANAGEMENT UNIT INSPECTIONS

There is one Treatment, Storage, and Disposal (TSD) unit in the 400 Area with two active containerized storage areas of mixed waste, governed by the requirements of the *Hanford Facility RCRA Permit* (WA7 89000 8967). One of these storage areas is inside the Building 403 (Fuel Storage Facility [FSF]); the other storage area is on the Interim Storage Area (ISA). The mixed waste stored in these areas is limited exclusively to wastes identified in the Part A Permit for the 400 Area Waste Management Unit. As required (letter, Department of Ecology to Department of Energy, 12-NWP-024, dated February 21, 2012), weekly inspections of each active storage area are to be conducted. These inspections ensure the waste remains in a safe configuration with respect to potential impacts on personnel or the environment. Other inspections are also performed as defined in the permit (Addendum I, Inspections).

#### 3.3.1 FSF WMU Inspection

The FSF (indoor) inspection will consist of a visual inspection of the containers' integrity and other items described in the permit. In addition, the argon cover gas supply to the storage boxes will be verified.

#### 3.3.2 ISA WMU Inspection



The ISA inspection will also consist of a visual check of the containers' integrity and other items described in the permit.

#### Justification and Impacts of Change:

Ecology transmitted a letter dated February 21, 2012 to DOE directing that the 400 Area WMU container inspections be returned to weekly from semi-annual. Weekly inspections have been initiated and the Hanford Facility RCRA Permit is being modified to incorporate the required changes.
