
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There were five open comments on the subject work plan that led to initiation of the dispute. Ecology and RL Project Managers met on March 12, 2008, and resolved four of the five comments. The fifth comment, Number 25, stating Ecology's expectations for risk assessment exposure scenarios in the 200 Area Core Zone was agreed to be beyond the scope of the work plan. The project manager level dispute on the work plan is therefore considered to be resolved. Resolution of the dispute was also discussed in the March 20, 2008, 200 Area Unit Managers Meeting, where it was agreed that RL would transmit this letter to provide additional documentation in addition to the meeting minutes.
