This form documents agreement among parties listed authorizing classification of the subject unit as Closed Out, Interim Closed Out, No Action, RCRA Postclosure, Rejected, or Consolidated. This form also authorizes backfill of the waste management unit, if appropriate, for Closed Out and Interim Closed out units. Final removal from the NPL of No Action and Closed Out waste management units will occur at a future date.

Description of Current Waste Site Conditions:

(Summarize status of investigation/remediation of the waste sites.)

In 1995, a decision was made to dismantle the towers and ship them off site to another Federal agency. On April 10, 1995, when the contractor attempted to cut the base of the first leg of the first tower, green liquid was noticed draining out of the tower leg. The contractor stopped work and reported the situation. A maximum of 2.7 liters (0.72 gallons) of liquid had been released to the soil. One cubic foot of damp soil was removed from the spill site and six, 10 gram soil samples were collected. Three soil samples found less than detectable levels of ethylene glycol. Two samples contained ethylene glycol levels below quantities of concern. One sample contained 3830 milligrams of ethylene glycol per kilogram of soil. The spill was less than the CERCLA reportable quantity (RQ) of 5000 pounds.

Basis for Reclassification:

600-256 was Reclassified to No Action in 2004. This site is listed on Table A-2a, 200-UR-1 Operable Unit Waste Sites That are Identified as Rejected or No Action, DOE/RL-2004-39, Rev. 0, 200-UR-1 Unplanned Release Waste Group Operable Unit Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study Work Plan. In 2007 the definitions for "Rejected" and "No Action" were revised. The classification of this site should be changed to "Rejected" to align with the revised definitions in the TPA-MP-14 procedure.
