




Tri-Party Agreement

TWENTY-ONE DAY EXTENSION TO RESPOND TO HANFORD FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT AND CONSENT ORDER (TRI-PARTY AGREEMENT) CHANGE REQUEST C-08-07 "TRANSFER 200-MG-1 OU PIPELINE RELATED WASTE UNITS TO THE 200-IS-1 OU, TRANSFER OF THE 216-B-60 WASTE UNIT FROM THE 200-MG-1 OU TO THE 200-PW-2 OU AND DELETE THE 2607-EC WASTE UNIT FROM THE 200-MG-1 OU"

A twenty-one day extension for responding to the U. S. Department of Energy's (DOE) signed Tri-Party Agreement Change Form C-08-07 "Transfer 200-MG-1 OU Pipeline Related Waste Units to the 200-IS-1 OU, Transfer of the 216-B-60 Waste Unit from the 200-MG-1 OU to the 200-PW-2 OU and Delete the 2607-EC Waste Unit from the 200-MG-1 OU" is agreed to by the DOE and the State of Washington Department of Ecology. This extension will enable the completion of appropriate reviews prior to providing a response. Therefore, the fourteen day response time specified in Tri-Party Agreement Action Plan Section 12.3.3 is extended by twenty-one days from August 29, 2008 to September 19, 2008 for Change Form C-08-07.
