Change Title Transfer 216-S-16D Waste Unit from 200-MG-2 to 200-MG-1 Operable Unit		
Description/Justification of Change <p>Approval of this change package will transfer the 216-S-16D Waste Unit (Site) from the 200-MG-2 Operable Unit (OU) to the 200-MG-1 OU in the Tri-Party Agreement Appendix C. Currently there is a distinction between the two OUs where 200-MG-1 has a combination of waste sites both inside and outside the 200E and 200W Areas fence lines, whereas 200-MG-2 has only waste sites within the fence lines. Making this change will allow 200-MG-2 to be consistent with this distinction, and remedial decisions to be conducted in a more straightforward manner.</p> <p>On the next page changes to the Tri-Party Agreement Appendix C are shown as strikeout for deleted text and <u>highlight</u> for added text. Only the affected Waste Unit transfer is shown in the Operable Units.</p>
