A. LLBG Permit Status

Lori Fritz (CHPRC) reported that the components of the groundwater monitoring plan relevant to the sampling analysis plan are in CHPRC review. Stuart Luttrell (CHPRC) stated that he was preparing comments to send to Ecology by the end of today. Deborah Singleton (Ecology) stated that the groundwater monitoring plan is in review, and that Low Level Waste Management Area 4 (LLMA-4) may be required to go from detection monitoring to compliance monitoring, due to the

recent exceedance. The exceedance is under CHPRC investigation, and Ecology will base its decision on the results of the investigation.

Ms. Singleton suggested that the parties move expeditiously with procedural closure for the un-used areas in an effort to incorporate them into the upcoming sitewide permit modification in July 2009. Ms. Singleton stated that Ecology intends to address the used portions through CERCLA.

B. Groundwater Sampling

Mr. Luttrell reported that three of the six wells scheduled for sampling in March have been sampled in Waste Management Area 3. Samples from three wells were collected in WMA-4, which were for the groundwater quality assessment, first determination evaluation associated with the exceedances of TOC.
