



V. Near Term Schedules and Ongoing Activities (Milestones, TSD Unit)

A. LLBG Permit Status

Deborah Singleton (Ecology) stated that Ecology has been working internally on the groundwater monitoring plan that was submitted last year, and the groundwater monitoring plan is being split into three plans and waste management areas as follows: LLWMA-3 and 4; LLWMA-1; LLWMA-2. Ms. Singleton noted that LLWMA-2 will be heavily impacted by the ZP-1 pump and treat, and it needed to be separated out from LLWMA-1 with additional language to address the pump and treat.

Tony Miskho (CHPRC) suggested holding a separate meeting, before Ecology proceeds further in splitting the groundwater monitoring plans, to discuss RL and

Ecology's intent to reduce the footprint of the TSD burial grounds regarding the operating areas and the used areas. Mr. Collins took an action to set up a meeting. Greg Berlin (CHPRC) is working on the procedural closure package for the unused areas, and he estimated the package would be sent to Ecology later in October 2009.

B. Groundwater Sampling

Ms. Singleton stated that Stuart Luttrell (CHPRC) indicated to her that there was nothing new to report for groundwater sampling.

VI. Approved Changes Signed off in Accordance with TPA Section 12.2

A. There were no approved changes signed.

VII. General Discussion

A. Lori Fritz (CHPRC) reported that the Notice of Construction (NOC) for the TRU retrieval project is being revised, and should be ready for the Department of Health's review within two weeks. The revised NOC will provide authorization to repackage all the degraded boxes in the field, including boxes 80 and 82. In the meantime, a three-sided carton is being engineered to cover the boxes to contain the contamination.

B. Ms. Singleton inquired about the ARRA funding. Ms. Fritz responded that the entire retrieval project is under ARRA.
