



A. T Plant Permit Status

Lori Fritz (CHPRC) stated that once the WRAP waste analysis plan and the issues with CWC are closed out, the focus will turn to the T Plant permit. Deborah Singleton (Ecology) introduced Dan McDonald (Ecology) as the new lead for the SWOC units. Mr. McDonald has been reviewing RL/CHPRC's response to comments, the addendums, conditions, and the Part 1's and 2's for the WRAP permit in an effort to develop a template for the remaining SWOC permits. Ms. Singleton noted that there will be exceptions from the template that are unit-specific. Joel Williams (CHPRC) reported that the review on Addendum C for T Plant is nearing completion.

Mike Collins (RL) provided Ms. Singleton the proposed language for the 2706-T tanks as part of the permit renewal. The initial intent is to attach the information to the meeting minutes. Paul Martin (CHPRC) stated that the two tanks are completely empty. The tank with pinhole leaks was opened, and it was determined that it was completely dry. The second tank was never used, and the lines will be blanked off in early September to prevent inadvertent waste additions to the tanks. It was agreed that Oliver Wang (Ecology) will be present when the lines are blanked off to verify the process. A report from Ecology will be provided at the next PMM to document acceptance of the process.

VI. Approved Changes Signed off in Accordance with TPA Section 12.2

A. There were no changes to sign.

VII. General Discussion

A. Ms. Fritz stated that under the ARRA work scope for TRU waste repackaging, new operators are being trained for a second shift, and the intent is to have the crews working by October 1, 2009.
