






V. Near Term Schedules and Ongoing Activities (Milestones, TSD Unit)

A. LLBG Permit Status

There was no change in status since the August PMM. Deborah Singleton (Ecology) stated that Ecology continues to work internally on the groundwater monitoring plan. Ecology is still proceeding with splitting the groundwater monitoring plan into three separate plans which will address low level waste management areas 1, 2, and 3 and 4 combined. Ms. Singleton indicated that the permits will be separated into an operating permit (trenches 31, 34 and 94) and a permit for the used area. Ms. Singleton noted that there are two approaches being considered for closing the un-used portion of the burials grounds, either through procedural closure or by providing documentation to support closing the un-used portion in the permit. Ms. Singleton stated her preference for providing the documentation and making note in the permit that the un-used areas are closed. Greg Berlin (CHPRC) is in the process of providing Ecology the documentation for that approach.

Tony Miskho (CHPRC) inquired about how a waste management area with an operating trench and a used area would be managed. Ms. Singleton responded that Ecology is working the issue regarding the division of a permitting area and a groundwater monitoring plan. Mr. Miskho initiated a discussion that was brought up at the last PMM, that he had received direction from RL to shrink the boundaries of the used waste management areas. Ms. Singleton responded that Ecology will be taking the position to not support shrinking the boundaries of the used areas.

B. Groundwater Sampling

Stuart Luttrell (CHPRC) reported the schedule for groundwater sampling. Waste Management Area (WMA) 1 was sampled in June and will be sampled again in December. WMA 2 will be sampled in October. WMA 3 was sampled in September. WMA 4 was sampled in July and August, and the next sampling will be in January 2010.
