


- I. Approval of August 27, 2009 Purgewater Project Managers Meeting Minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/CHPRC).
 - A. The PMM minutes were approved.

- II. Operational Status
 - A. Rick Oldham (CHPRC) reported that 19,396 gallons of purgewater were sent to ETF, and 5,111 gallons were sent to the modutank. Drilling continues with the six new extraction and injection wells in ZP-1, one well in 100-K and two wells 100-H. Preparations are being made to drill the K well near B Plant, four wells in the 100-B/C Area, and 171 apatite injection wells in 100N. The inspection of the Unit 2 liner was completed and it was approved. Construction on unit No. 3 has started, and about 60% of the walls are up.

- III. Status of Previous Agreements and Commitments
 - A. There were no previous agreements or commitments to status.

- IV. New Agreements and Commitments
 - A. There were no new agreements or commitments.

- V. Near Term Schedules and Ongoing Activities (Milestones, TSD Unit)
 - A. Modutank Replacement
Mr. Oldham reported that the Removal Action Work Plan (RAWP) for units 2 and 3 was approved on September 9, 2009. CHPRC is continuing to disposition comments on the closure plan for Unit 1. Tony Miskho (CHPRC) is developing a list of unresolved issues and recommendations for the closure plan for RL/CHPRC and Ecology to review before another version of the closure plan is sent to Ecology. Mr. Miskho stated that there is different terminology being used for the modutanks, and the old Unit 2 is now being referred to as the new CERCLA Unit 1, and Unit 3 is referred to as the new CERCLA Unit 2. Brian Dixon (CHPRC) noted that it had not been officially decided what the new names would be. Kathy Conaway (Ecology) added that dangerous waste should be attached to Unit 1 since it is under the dangerous waste requirement.

- VI. Approved Changes Signed off in Accordance with TPA Section 12.2
 - A. There were no changes to sign.

- VII. General Discussion
 - A. Mr. Miskho initiated a discussion regarding the process for discontinuing the purgewater strategy, which needs to be addressed in the near future. Rick Bond

(Ecology) stated that Ecology and EPA are working on incorporating the purgewater strategy language into the investigative derived waste (IDW) strategy. It was noted and agreed that the IDW calls out the purgewater strategy, and to discontinue the purgewater strategy, the IDW would have to be reviewed. Mr. Miskho stated that revising the IDW document would be a lengthy process, noting that it was last revised in 1999. Mr. Miskho explained that the purgewater is currently being managed as nonlisted waste through the purgewater strategy, and when the purgewater strategy is discontinued, a system will be needed to manage the listed waste in purgewater trucks. Mr. Bond stated that an internal meeting is scheduled next week for discussion on the IDW.
