I. Approval of September 24, 2009 T Plant Complex Project Meeting Minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/CHPRC)

A. The PMM minutes were approved.

II. Operational Status

Paul Martin (M&EC) provided Michelle Mandis (Ecology) a draft of the new format being proposed for operational status. The same format was provided at the LLBG PMM. Mr. Martin noted that T Plant and WRAP are combined in the new format for the TRU waste program. Ms. Mandis inquired about treatment or storage numbers in the new format. Mike Collins (RL) responded that treatment and storage numbers will continue to be reported in the M-91 PMM status. Lori Fritz (CHPRC) added that the main activity at T Plant and WRAP is TRU repackaging, and the purpose of the new format is to reflect facility outputs. Ms. Mandis indicated she would discuss the new format with Deborah Singleton (Ecology).
