 - A. CWC Permit Status Mike Collins (RL) stated that the order of focus for the Solid Waste Operating Complex (SWOC) unit permits has been revised. WRAP is now the first SWOC unit permit to be addressed, then CWC, T Plant, and Low Level Burial Grounds in that order. Kathy Conaway (Ecology) concurred with the order of the SWOC permits, and stated that she has been assigned the permit writing responsibilities for the SWOC units.

 - A. There were no approved changes signed.

- VII. General Discussion
 - A. Mr. Collins noted that a maintenance facility for the ERDF roll-off boxes is being built south of the main CWC complex. The purpose of the facility is to perform maintenance on the roll-off boxes. Ms. Conaway asked if this activity would require additional information to be included in the CWC permit. Paul Martin responded that it is not considered a permitted activity, and the facility will be operating under generator provisions.
