- I. Approval of January 28, 2010 Liquid Waste and Fuels Storage Project Manager Meeting Minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/CHPRC).
 - A. The PMM minutes were approved. NOTE: Subsequent to the approval of the January 28, 2010 meeting minutes, a typographical error was discovered in the operational report for December 2009. The report indicated that the liquid level in Basin 44 at the end of December was 29.1 feet. The correct level 20.9 feet. The January 2010 minutes were corrected prior to submittal to the Administrative Record. The parties agreed to document the change via this note in the February PMM minutes.

- II. Operational Status
 - A. Harlan Boynton (CHPRC) reported that in starting in May, ETF will begin processing waste water.

A. ETF/LERF Dangerous Waste Permit Status

Kathy Conaway (Ecology) reported that she and Rick Bond (Ecology) have had internal discussions with their groundwater support on the LERF groundwater monitoring plan. Ms. Conaway noted that since ETF is such a robust facility and receives many different waste streams, a permit condition was added to conduct an annual evaluation of the waste streams in association with the LERF groundwater monitoring plan. The evaluation will note any changes in constituents that may need to be added to the existing list of constituents. Ms. Conaway indicated that the groundwater monitoring plan and permit conditions are basically completed, and she estimated the pieces will be put together and ready for transmittal for RL/CHPRC review by March 2010.

B. 310/340 Status

Operations have been discontinued and the facilities will be turned over to Washington Closure for disposition.
