III. Project Specific Issues

A. ETF/LERF Dangerous Waste Permit Status

Rick Bond (Ecology) stated that the permit condition language for the additional well has not yet been inserted into the statement of basis. Tony Miskho (CHPRC) requested a final review of the permit, since it had been some time since the last workshop, to ensure that the language for the additional well and information such as the Purgewater unloading tank and the training plan are what was agreed to. An action was established for Ecology to provide RL a full permit renewal package for a final check. A target completion date was set for a month from today. Mr. Bond stated that a new person will be transitioning into Kathy Conaway's (Ecology) position as permit writer for the LWFS permits; however, Ms. Conaway will continue oversight until the permits are completed.

~~III~~ Mr. Bond raised an issue within Ecology regarding RL's intent to submit a Class ~~II~~ modification. Mr. Miskho stated that the modification is currently in CHPRC concurrence for transmittal to RL. Mr. Bond suggested that RL contact Ron Skinnarland (Ecology) to discuss the issue. Ecology does not intend to make any more modifications to the RCRA sitewide permit until after it is issued.

B. 310/340 Status

RL is awaiting CHPRC's proposal.

C. ST4502 Permit Status

There was no change in status reported on the ST4502 permit.

D. ST4500 Permit Status

There was no change in status reported on the ST4500 permit.
