

- I. Approval of September 23, 2010 WESF Project Managers Meeting Minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/CHPRC)
  - A. The PMM meeting minutes were approved.
  
- II. Operational Status
  - A. Fen Simmons (CHPRC) reported that spraying of 225B roof is ongoing and should be complete in the next couple of months.

- VII. General Discussion
  - A. The parties discussed the clunk test. The test is currently performed randomly to confirm that the capsules are not leaking. Rick Bond (Ecology) noted that Stacy Nichols will be providing permit support to WESF and asked that she be provided with a tour of the facility. He also asked the status of milestone M-92-05. The milestone calls for establishment of a path forward for ultimate disposition of the capsules by June 30, 2017.
  - B. Mr. Bond initiated discussion about having an open end date for closure of the TSD and suggested that something be placed in a milestone, permit or LDR report. He suggested that it could be a plan for a plan. Tony McKarns (RL) noted that the TPA is cited in Attachment 1 of the Dangerous Waste Permit and it would not be necessary to duplicate information in the permit. Mr. Miskho noted that the LDR report is already referenced in the permit and the appropriate place for treating and disposing waste is the LDR report.

Mr. Miskho asked Mr. Bond if the permit renewal documentation is complete for WESF. Mr. Bond responded that the state Attorney General's office had reviewed it and that all comments except one on closure date have been resolved. Mr. Miskho reiterated that RL/CHPRC are under the assumption that WESF is now complete and the last version they reviewed will be what will be going out for public review.
