

A. LERF/200 Area ETF Dangerous Waste Permit Status

Gus Aljure (CHPRC) reported that the Class 1 permit modification to incorporate revisions to the current permit was signed by Ecology. CHPRC is proceeding internally with the process of certifying the Part A and getting the notification form signed. It is anticipated that RL will transmit the Part A to Ecology within two weeks for approval. Mr. Aljure noted that the Class 1 mod is not impacted by the Class 3 mod for the groundwater permit conditions. Mr. Aljure stated that there is no change in the status of the Class 3 mod, although CHPRC is considering drafting language for submittal to Ecology in an effort to get some agreement for the groundwater portion. Monica Kembel (CHPRC) asked about the status of permit renewal. Mr. Aljure stated that Ecology has indicated a tentative schedule for a final RL/CHPRC and EPA review of the individual permits, and then going out for the public review process in the July 2011 time frame. Following the public review and comment period, comments will be incorporated into the permits and the overall Hanford RCRA sitewide permit would be published in November 2011. At that time the Class 3 permit mod will be incorporated into the 200 Area ETF permit. It was reiterated that the time frame for permit renewal is very tentative.

B. WESF Dangerous Waste Permit Status

Mr. Aljure stated that the status of the WESF permit is the same as the LERF/200 Area ETF permits as far as the schedule for permit renewal.

C. ST4502 Permit Status

Stacy Nichols (Ecology) stated that she is working intermittently on the 4502 permit due to other priorities.

D. ST4500 Permit Status

There was no change in status of the ST4500 permit. Ms. Nichols stated that MSA is gathering comments from the different contractors regarding the 4511 permit and will be providing her the comments.
