
(What is the current physical state of the site? What activities have been performed?)

The septic system was abandoned in 1999 per the requirements of Washington Administrative Code 246-272-1851. When excavated, the tank was empty and dry. No samples were collected. The tank was backfilled in place to eliminate void spaces. Per an agreement with the Washington Department of Health, the septic system lids were left in place. Two posts and a WIDS Sitecode sign mark the location of the tile field.

Basis for reclassification:

The waste site should be reclassified to Rejected because it was abandoned per WAC codes in 1999.
