

1. Approval of Past Minutes

The January 16, 2003 Project Manager Meeting (PMM) minutes were approved.

2. Efficiency Issues

There were no efficiency issues to discuss.

3. General Discussion

- 305-B & 325 HWTUs Quarterly Permit Modifications

G. Grohs (PNNL) reported that the next quarterly modification Ecology will receive would contain changes to the 305-B chapter 3 Waste analysis Plan. Changes are still being made to the text in the 305-B and RPL BEPs and these changes will be submitted in the following quarter class on modifications.

- Legacy Waste Status

B. Bjorklund (PNNL) had nothing to report, things are moving along as planned.

- Status on listed waste ONO

H. Tilden (PNNL) reported that PNNL has evaluated the analytical data for the drums sampled. There was one hit above detection on contaminants of concern. Ecology was contacted to see what standards are used for evaluation of the data. Ecology stated that the groundwater protection standard is to be used. Ecology is evaluating the possibility of specifying contingent management standards requiring disposal in the low level burial ground.

- Discuss Agenda Items

T. Aldridge (DOE-RL) distributed a proposed revised agenda for the meetings (Attachment 5) including a proposal that PMM meetings be held once a quarter vs. once a month. M. Anderson-Moore (Ecology) stated that she would not like to reduce the meeting frequency to once a quarter; she finds that the monthly meetings are helpful. F. Jamison (Ecology) suggested if the meetings are not held monthly, an informal e-mail report might be an alternative; he likes having some sort of information provided on a monthly basis. He stated that PNNL, DOE-RL, and Ecology have a good working relationship and good communication partially due to these meetings. Ecology will discuss the possibility of having these meetings every other month and will provide feedback at the March meeting.

them. Since Ecology has no comments, a separate response will not be provided by Ecology. Ecology concurrence is evidenced by these meeting minutes.

- M. Anderson-Moore (Ecology) asked what RL/PNNL information indicated that the drum sent to the Low-Level Burial Grounds contained transuranic waste with low levels of PCBs. P. Crane (PNNL) explained that the information was gained from a logbook entry of the staff member that performs non-destructive assay. The entry for a container with the same barcode number as that shipped to FH (assayed in 2000) indicates PCB K Basin Waste and a corresponding assay report number. T. Aldridge (RL) asked if Ecology had concluded its inquiry into this activity. M. Anderson-Moore said that the inquiry is continuing pending an internal meeting to discuss it further. One concern is that the mismatch between the container number and the contents was not discovered sooner in the disposal process. F. Jamison (Ecology) stated that Ecology's concerns do not rise to the level of orders or notice of violation, but they are still reviewing the questions they have.

4. Action Items

T. Aldridge (DOE-RL) to telephone Ecology if there are any changes to the RLWS status within 325 building. A deadline has been set for February 1, 2003. Milestone was missed. T. Aldridge returned from travel and was scheduled to sit down with new 325 manager, but drum issue surfaced. Action will remain open, T. Aldridge will complete.
