
Subject(s) Discussed/Summary of Discussions:
County land use plan was adopted in April 1995. I will be receiving a copy soon.

Franklin County is primarily agriculture and is not greatly impacted by Hanford cycles. Some people move in and out but the annexation of the Riverside District has added enough population to offset any changes as a result of layoffs at Hanford.

Dick would not comment on impacts to law enforcement. Referred me to Sheriff Latham.

Fire protection would not be impacted. The County relies largely on volunteers. These volunteers come primarily from the rural farm population and participation is largely unaffected by Hanford cycles.

Dick indicated that the City of Pasco is much more vulnerable to events at Hanford and referred me to Rick Smith at City Hall for more detail.
