
**Subject(s) Discussed/Summary of Discussions:**

Pat told me they are currently building a new high school. There are no plans to build additional schools...they will be renovating/modernizing some of the older schools (apparently Cushing is in error).

Currently high schools are over capacity. Elementary is near capacity but has moved into modular class rooms to get more space. The new high school will help meet projected growth but, if there is any growth beyond what has been projected, the schools will be overtaxed.

Projections are based on standard demographic calculations for cohort survival beginning with kindergarten. Adjustments are made based on conversations with large employers in the area, including Hanford contractors.

Need for schools is based on the following changes in student population:  
For every 500 new elementary students, a new school is needed  
For every 800 new middle school students a new school is needed  
For every 1500 new high school students, a new school is needed.
