SOLID WASTE REMOVAL FROM THE SIMULATED HIGH-LEVEL WASTE SLURRY TREATMENT AND STORAGE (SHLWS T/S) UNIT

In accordance with condition V.4.B.e. of the Dangerous Waste Portion of the Hanford Facility Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Permit for the Treatment, Storage, and Disposal of Dangerous Waste; this notifies you of the final disposition of solid waste generated during soil sampling and decontamination activities at the SHLWS T/S unit. The solid waste referenced in the Permit condition refers to a single drum of solid material generated during the activities. An evaluation of the data generated from the analyses of the soil and rinsate samples indicate that the solid waste does not designate as a dangerous waste as defined in the Washington Dangerous Waste Regulations, Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 173-303. As a result of this designation, the solid waste was removed from the site on May 23, 1995, and shipped to the Hanford Central Waste Landfill for disposal.
