Summary of Discussion and Commitments/Agreements

1. Approval of Past UMM Minutes

November 22, 1994, and December 13, 1994, Unit Managers Meeting minutes have been approved but have not been signed at this time.

2. Status Action Items

- No open action items.

3. Status Closure Activities

- NOD Responses

ZC Knaus commented that he has completed draft responses to Ecology's NODs for 105-DR. He asked for input on the responses that have been prepared to ensure the responses are acceptable. Ecology (SE McKinney) is still reviewing draft responses and will give his evaluation of the NOD responses in the near future.

4. New Business

- Use of the Debris Rule at 105-DR

SE McKinney stated that the Debris Rule would be applicable at 105-DR. He recommended applying it to the burn vessel located in the Small Fire Room, which was the only area used to burn lithium-lead alloy, in lieu of sampling. The Debris Rule gives many different treatment options available as long as one meets the Debris Rule performance standard. The performance standard is a clean debris surface with less than five percent waste remaining. SE McKinney commented that no matter what treatment is selected, produced treatment residue must be sampled to classify it as dangerous waste or not.

- Designation limits of lithium and sodium carbonates

SE McKinney suggested that, because both lithium and sodium carbonates are state only wastes; they can be remediated by using an Ecology approved alternative treatment. He stated that, because action levels for both of the carbonates are relatively high, a visual inspection would be acceptable. SE McKinney offered the following guidance on the carbonate issue: clean up all visible deposits by washing, collect and sample treatment residue to complete decontamination activities.

5. Set Next Meeting Date

The next UMM will be held on March 6, 1995, Federal Building, Rm 784B, Richland, Washington.
