

**The Hanford Site Hazardous Waste Permit** was issued in August 1994. The permit contains general conditions for the operation and closure of hazardous waste treatment, storage and disposal sites at Hanford. The modifications would add to the hazardous waste permit the three sites or units (listed to the left) which will be closed.

**Public Comment:** Ecology seeks to learn issues of public concern about the application. A 45-day public comment on the application begins **June 8** and ends **July 24, 1995**.
