

Re: Interim Remedial Measures Program Plan (M-15)


During the fall 1991, 100 Area scoping discussions the three parties identified several documents to be written by the United States Department of Energy (USDOE). The purpose of these documents was to define a integrated approach to implement existing 100 Area commitments. To date, the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) has not received the Interim Remedial Measures Program Plan (IRMPP). This document was due August 1, 1992

The Hanford Past Practice Strategy (HPPS) was developed to accelerate cleanups on Hanford. Currently there are no accelerated cleanups scheduled. The IRMPP is intended to set forth a schedule for implementating the HPPS. Ecology is concerned that USDOE failure to transmit, negotiate, and resolve regulatory comments on this document will result in missing the construction window for FY 1993.
