

Dear Ron:

It has come to my attention that our approval of the Haxone Remediation Demonstration Activity scheduled for June of this year was only verbal in one of our monthly meetings on the Radioactive Air Emissions Program. Your staff has requested that, for the sake of documentation, written approval be provided, even though it is after the fact.

As discussed in our meeting where the approval was given, we agreed with Westinghouse staff that the offsite radiological impact was insignificant. The source term was technically radioactive, but extremely small. While understanding that you did not initially request approval, but were giving us notification, we agreed with the analysis of the project and granted approval anyway. Consider the approval documented.
