

## Ecology hearing set on Hanford permit

Washington's Ecology Department has scheduled a public hearing from 7 to 9 p.m. Wednesday on modifications to the Hanford Hazardous Waste Permit.

The hearing in the department's Nuclear Waste Program office, 1315 W. Fourth Ave., Kennewick, will be for public comment on proposals for five waste management closures at Hanford.

They are the 216-B-3 expansion ponds, 2101 M pond, the simulated high-level waste slurry unit, 218-E-8 Borrow Pit demolition site, and the 200 West Area ash pit demolition pit.

A 45-day public comment period on the modifications will end March 2. Written comments should be sent to Moses Jaraysi at the waste program office.



# Hanford Public Hearing

The Washington State Department of Ecology intends to modify the U.S. Department of Energy's Hanford Site Facility Wide Hazardous Waste Permit. The permit contains general conditions for the operation and closure of hazardous waste treatment, storage, and disposal sites on the Hanford Site. The modifications would add to the hazardous waste permit five sites or units which will be closed. The units are the 216-B-3 Expansion ponds, 2101 M pond, Simulated High Level Waste Slurry unit, 218-E-8 Borrow Pit Demolition Site, 200 West Area Ash Pit Demolition Site.
