Review of the Plan and Schedule for Disposition and Regulatory Compliance for Miscellaneous Streams 389
(DOE/RL-93-94, Rev. 1) (Plan and Schedule) has been completed by the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology). The Plan and Schedule is approved as written with one clarification. Water discharged to the ground for a beneficial use (e.g., water for irrigation, aesthetics, or dust control) does not require permitting under Chapter 173-216 of Washington State Administrative Code (WAC). However, these discharges are required to meet the Water Quality Standards defined in WAC 173-200.
