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

**Summary of Discussion and Commitments/Agreements**

**1. Approval of Past UMM Minutes**

November UMM minutes were signed by the Ecology Unit manager. The RL Unit Manager was not present.

**2. Status of Action Items**

**3. Status Closure Activities**

- Clean Closure Evaluation Report

Ecology (Mr. R. E. Cordts) confirmed receipt of the following CCER related information:

- RL transmittal copy of the *2727-S Nonradioactive Dangerous Waste Facility Clean Closure Evaluation Report (CCER)*, WHC-SD-EN-TI-242, Rev. 0.
- Copies of the following documents requested at the November UMM that were referenced in the CCER or otherwise pertain to closure:
  - sampling field logbook (EFL-1038),
  - sampling authorization form (SAF) 92-262 for sampling required by the closure plan, and
  - SAF 92-309 for sample of the oil-spill.

Ecology (Mr. R. E. Cordts) indicated that he was uncertain whether he had received the full validation package for the unit verification sampling. WHC (Mr. S. N. Luke) indicated that WHC would provide a copy of the appropriate portions of the validation package to Ecology if needed.

Ecology suggested that all of its comments on the CCER be combined into one comprehensive response table and then added to future meeting minutes as an appendix. This would serve to document all comments in the administrative record. WHC indicated that such a table would be initiated and provided to Ecology.

Along those lines, Ecology indicated that the Administrative Record is also the appropriate location for unit operating records because the unit has been demolished and such records can not be stored on site.

WHC (Mr. S. N. Luke) reiterated that under the conditions of the Hanford Facility RCRA Permit (RCRA Permit), all remaining physical closure activities (site restoration only) had to be completed by March 27, 1995. In order not to impact achievement of that date, it was hoped that CCER (Revision 0) along with a table documenting acceptable responses to all Ecology comments would yield a letter of concurrence from Ecology on the CCER findings. Obtaining such a letter would allow field activities to proceed while the CCER was corrected in the appropriate manner (e.g., page changes, addendum, errata sheets, full revision). Ecology indicated that such a letter could be provided under those conditions. Certification would then follow within 60 days of completion of the closure activities, or no later than May 26, 1995 in accordance with the RCRA Permit.

**- Removal of Barrels and Demolition Debris**

WHC (Mr. S. N. Luke) indicated that activities were underway to transport the barreled waste soils and palletized piping remnants now at the site to Hanford's Central Waste Landfill and to dispose of it there as nondangerous waste.

**- Notification of Initiation of Closure Activities**

Ecology confirmed the receipt of the letter from RL notifying Ecology of initiation of 2727-S NRDWS closure activities.

**4. New Business**

**- New Ecology Telephone Number**

Ecology identified that as of January 15, 1995 his phone number would have a new Area Code and would now be 360-407-7142.

**- Closure Cost Estimates**

Ecology acknowledged receipt of a report regarding TSD unit closure cost estimates.
