#### Summary of Discussion and Commitments/Agreements

#### 1. Approval of Past Unit Managers Meeting Minutes

The April 20, 1995 Unit Manager Meeting minutes were approved.

#### 2. Analytical Results Status

- **Data Evaluation Report Transmittal Letter**

RL/PNL will formally transmit the data evaluation report to Ms. G. Davis (Ecology). It was agreed during the meeting that Ms. Davis' signature of the 6-1-95 SHLWS meeting minutes will represent Ecology's receipt and approval of the data evaluation report, and that an RL/PNL transmittal letter will not be required.

- **Ecology Letter on Soil Analysis Lead Concentration**

Mr. B. Day (PNL) referred to the Ecology letter documenting the one high lead concentration sample. Ms. Davis stated that the objective for filing the letter with the Administrative Record is to ensure that if any future activities take place at the unit, that the sample will be noted. Ms. Davis added that this action has no bearing on the closure of the unit.

- **Disposition of Solid Waste Barrel**

Mr. W. Slater (PNL) stated that the barrel was moved 5-23-95, and that it was managed as solid waste. Ecology will be receiving a letter documenting removal of the barrel. Mr. Slater added that the unit will continue to be inspected on a monthly basis until a letter is received from Ecology verifying closure certification. Ms. Davis stated that she will draft a letter to RL stating that monthly inspections are no longer required and transmit the letter the beginning of next week.

#### 3. Hanford Facility Permit Modification Status

Mr. Day stated that the SHLWS permit conditions went into effect on 5-28-95. One of the permit conditions states that RL/PNL will submit to Ecology within 30 days of the effective date of the permit modification (5-28-95) that PNL will continue to clean close SHLWS.

**4. Status of PE Certification**

Mr. Day will send a letter to Ecology transmitting the professional engineer's (PE) closure certification.

**5. Yakima Indian Nations Letter**

Ms. E. Mattlin (RL) stated that she had a discussion with Mr. K. Clarke (RL) regarding the public comment period for SHLWS closure. Mr. Clarke had suggested that RL/PNL's response regarding the Yakima Indian Nation's (YIN) comments, which were received after the public comment period closed, should note the time frame for the public comment period. Ms. Davis stated that the YIN maintain they are a stakeholder and not the public, and therefore are not held by the public comment time frame. Ms. Davis requested a copy of the RL letter to the YIN.

**6. Status Action Items**

- **New Action Items**

There were no new action items generated during the meeting.

- **Old Action Items**

There were no old action items to status.

**7. General Discussion**

Ms. Mattlin stated that RL received a letter from Ecology stating that the SHLWS analytical results indicate no observed contamination remains at this site from the activities of the treatment, storage and disposal (TSD) facility; that closure of this TSD may proceed; and that no remediation of the site, due to the activities of the TSD, is necessary.

**6. Next Unit Managers Meeting**

Ecology, RL and PNL discussed the need for future Unit Managers Meetings. A meeting will be scheduled on an as-needed basis.
