

However, the U. S. Department of Energy (USDOE) is requested to modify pages 6-3 to 6-4 in each closure plan. This modification shall specify a second round of Data Quality Objective (DQO) meetings may be required to determine future sampling needs, if the initial sampling data indicates contamination by past demolition activities.

USDOE shall make the changes stated above prior to public comment and inclusion into the Hanford Facility Wide Permit.
