**PURPOSE OF VISIT:**

To conduct a field tour of the Rotary Mode Core Sampling Truck and Exhauster, for the purpose of learning more about the operation of the truck. Mr. Stone stated that this was not a regulatory visit.

**SUMMARY OF VISIT:**

**November 15, 1994**

Washington State Department of Ecology (WDOE) and WHC personnel met at approximately 9:00 am in Mr. Hamilton's office at 2704HV. Mr. Hamilton gave a brief summary of the planned schedule for the RMCS, and stated that the truck was currently preparing to sample 241-BY-106.

After the brief discussion WDOE and WHC personnel proceeded to the 241-BY Tank Farm to observe the RMCS Truck and Exhauster. At the farm WDOE personnel were able to get within 50 feet of the truck without going into the Tank Farm. Mr. Stone stated that since he was here to learn about the truck, he would like to go into the farm and get a close-up look. Mr. Hamilton stated that since the truck was going through the final steps prior to the start of sampling all the operators were working on the truck, and there were no available escorts who could enter the farm and be able to discuss how the truck and exhauster operated. Mr. Hamilton suggested that Mr. Stone review the training material on the operation of the truck and exhauster and then return in a few days to take a look at the truck. Mr. Stone suggested that November 30, 1994 would be a good day.

A copy of the training material was obtained, cleared, and given to Mr. Stone for review.
