The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is in receipt of the U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) letter, dated December 11, 1992 that requests a 45 day extension to address ARARs raised by the regulators in comments to 100 Area Feasibility Study Phases 1 and 2, Draft A. We recognize that addressing the ARARs for this effort may involve longer than the 30-days allowed for comment dispositions.
