

**COMPLETION OF HANFORD FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT AND CONSENT ORDER PROPOSED TARGET M-32-04-T01 - DESIGN STANDARDS REVIEW FOR ONE TANK FARM**

A review of the design standards for the 241-AW Tank Farm is presented in the attached document "Structural Integrity Evaluation of 241-AW Tank Farm Dangerous Waste Storage Tank Facilities," WHC-SD-WM-ER-126, Rev. 0. The review was performed as part of the facility integrity assessment as required by the Washington State Dangerous Waste Regulations (Washington Administrative Code 173-303-640 [2][c][i]). The review concluded that these double-shell tanks and their ancillary facilities are conservatively designed using the appropriate national codes and standards.
