### Summary of Discussion and Commitments/Agreements

#### 1. Approval of Past UMM Minutes

The July 13, 1993 Unit Managers' Meeting (UMM) minutes were approved and signed by the Unit Managers.

#### 2. Status Prior Action Items:

- 5-04-93:1 WHC and RL will submit a petition requesting approval of the sonification procedure for the determination of volatile organics in concrete by following the guidelines in WAC 173-303-110(5).

WHC (A.L. Prignano) reported that the petition for the sonification procedure was still undergoing review. WHC is currently responding to comments from RL.

#### 3. Status Closure Activities

- Status Sonification Procedure

This item was addressed in item 2.

#### 4. New Business

WHC (A. L. Prignano) gave a status of the soil sampling activities. Soil sampling took place on Tuesday, August 10, 1993. Samples consisting of soil and cobbles were collected for off-site analyses. Field screening activities performed during the sampling event included organic vapor analyses and radiation surveys. Both showed no detects. Aqueous extraction - headspace gas chromatography, another screening method, was performed later in the day on samples collected at the site. The results showed mostly non-detects. Two samples, including the one from the authoritative site, showed approximately 1 to 2 ppb perchloroethylene (PCE). This is at the detection limits of the instrumentation and well below any levels of concern. Screening for polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs) should be completed by the end of the day.

RL (R. N. Krekel) noted that Ecology plans to include the 300 ASE closure plan in the Hanford Facility Permit. There was general discussion concerning the schedule for closure included in the closure plan. In response to a question from Ecology, RL (R. N. Krekel) stated that the closure date will depend on the length of time required to approve the sonification procedure (for the analysis of volatiles in

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concrete) petition. Ecology (R. E. Cordts) replied that his group should have the authority to approve the petition and that they have been in contact with the laboratory personnel in Manchester reviewing the procedure. Ecology (R. E. Cordts) will contact RL (R. N. Krekel) to provide an estimate for the time required for the approval process. RL (R. N. Krekel) noted that input on this item will be provided with the comments on the Hanford Facility Permit.

5. **Set Next Meeting Date**

The next meeting was set for September 9, 1993, at 1:00 p.m. in Richland, Washington.
