Summary of Discussion and Commitments/Agreements

Note: This UMM was a telephone conference call with the Ecology Unit Manager, Mr. R. E. Cordts.

1. Approval of Past UMM Minutes.

Final meeting minutes for the April 6, 1993 UMM were received by Ecology but were as yet unreviewed.

2. Status of Action Items

3. Status Closure Activities
- Sampling Data Transmittal Confirmation Letter

Ecology (Mr. R. E. Cordts) confirmed having received the letter from RL confirming WHC transmittal by overnight mail of a package containing the laboratory analytical results and the validation report for site sampling to-date.

- Waste Designation for Soil Stored at the Site

WHC (Mr. S. N. Luke) indicated that WHC Solid Waste Engineering (SWE) had completed the waste designation process for containerized (drummed and bagged) waste soils at the 2727-S NRDWS Facility site. The SWE determination was that these soils do not require regulation as dangerous waste.

Ecology (Mr. R. E. Cordts) requested clarification of the designation activity performed by SWE. RL (Mr. R. N. Krekel) responded that for waste designation, SWE applies the WAC [173-303-70] designation process to the laboratory analytical results for samples from the soils in question. In this case SWE performed designation on 2727-S NRDWS Facility samples B07550, B07551 and B07562.

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- Data Evaluation Report

WHC (Mr. S. N. Luke) indicated that RCRA Closures is still currently evaluating 2727-S laboratory data in order to prepare a final data evaluation report that will address all contamination found at the site above detection levels. Regarding preparation of the data evaluation report: the Sampling Report, which will be a portion of the final report, is being reworked by Environmental Engineering; RCRA Closures was awaiting Integrated Risk Information System (IRIS) database information for certain constituents to assist with formulating appropriate cleanup levels; and, Hanford Analytical Services Management (HASM) is pursuing as laboratory error elevated inorganic results reported for sample B07555.

Ecology (Mr. R. E. Cordts) inquired about an expected completion date for the final report. WHC (Mr. S. N. Luke) responded that a completion date for the final report was not yet clear but that WHC was gathering information as expeditiously as possible in order to take advantage of the season for purposes of possible further sampling or remediation and for the final restoration and revegetation of the site.
