The Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR), is preparing a Public Health Assessment for the Hanford 1100 Area (DOE), Richland Washington. This public health assessment addresses only the 1100 Area, and not the other Hanford Superfund sites -- i.e., the 100, 200, and 300 Areas.
