
Dear Messrs. Rasmussen, Brog, and Sorensen:

Re: Debris Waste Returned to the 324, 325, and 327 Buildings

Thank you for the assistance of the U.S. Department of Energy (USDOE), Pacific Northwest National Laboratories (PNNL), and Babcock & Wilcox Hanford Company (B&W) personnel during the Washington State Department of Ecology's (Ecology) recent investigation of debris waste generated in the 324, 325, and 327 Buildings at the 300 Area of the Hanford Site.

Ecology's investigation revealed PNNL relied on conflicting information regarding designation of constituents within the debris waste streams from the 324, 325, and 327 Buildings. This problem was compounded by incomplete segregation of waste constituents that may designate as dangerous waste.


Although Ecology elects not to pursue enforcement at this time, we are concerned that this situation be corrected. USDOE, PNNL, and B&W must ensure their wastes are accurately designated according to Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 173-303-170 and WAC 173-303-070. Therefore, Ecology requests (within thirty [30] days of receipt of this letter) USDOE, PNNL, and B&W submit a report to Ecology describing steps taken to accurately designate and segregate debris waste streams from the 324, 325, and 327 Buildings. Ecology expects this report by March 17, 1997.
