Re: Procedural Closure of the 324 Sodium Pilot Plant

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) has reviewed information submitted for procedural closure of the 324 Sodium Pilot Plant.

Based on information submitted by Pacific Northwest National Laboratories and research of historical data, Ecology agrees procedural closure of the 324 Sodium Pilot Plant is appropriate, as outlined in section 6.3.3 of the Tri-Party Agreement.

A Focus sheet has been prepared and published in the Hanford Happenings, and will be mailed with the Hanford Update on February 26, 1997. Enclosed is a draft schedule to clearly define the processes which occur and the time frames in which they need to be completed. Upon completion of the 30 day public comment period, Ecology will address any comments received, and a final determination will be made.
