



SAMPLING AND ANALYSIS PLAN FOR THE 100-D PONDS VOLUNTARY REMEDIATION PROJECT
DOE/RL-96-43, DRAFT A

Please find attached the subject document for review. Because of the short review time, two copies of the document were hand delivered on June 7, 1996, to Mr. Keith Holiday, State of Washington, Department of Ecology. The document details the procedures for sampling the 100-D Ponds after the voluntary remediation is conducted, and subsequent analysis of the samples for verifying that the 100-D Ponds is clean. Data from this effort will be used in the revision of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976 closure plan for the 100-D Ponds.
