SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION AND COMMITMENTS/AGREEMENTS

Approve Minutes from Previous Project Manager Meeting

Mr. Ted Wooley, Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology); Mr. Dave Evans, Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office (RL); Mr. George Reddick, Fluor Daniel Hanford, Inc. (FDH); and Mr. Steve Godfrey, B&W Hanford Company (BWHC) approved and signed the meeting minutes from the September 11, 1997 B Plant Project Managers Meeting. Ms. Cindy Grant, Washington State Department of Health (WDOH), was not able to attend this meeting, her signature will not be required. The minutes were sent out prior to the meeting for review and all corrections were incorporated prior to approval. Mr. Ted Wooley requested Ecology's final approval of the End Point Document be added to the action item listing (**PMM-BP-97-14**).

Status of Organic Disposal to DSSI

Mr. Greg LeBaron (BWHC) reported the organic solvent waste was shipped to DSSI for disposition September 24, 1997. A letter will be prepared to document completion of this TPA Milestone.

Mr. LeBaron reported there are now 11 active and 86 inactive vessels at B Plant. Of the 14 inactive vessels containing liquid, 7 (later verified that this should have been 6) were emptied as of September, and 2 more have been emptied in October.

Miscellaneous Tanks Sampling and Analysis Plan (SAP) Comment Resolution/Approval

Mr. Wooley (Ecology) provided a conditional approval letter from Ecology for the B Plant Misc. Tanks SAP.

Mr. Fen Simmons (BWHC) reported that final approval for the SAP has been obtained, and is in the distribution process.

Two samples are ready to be taken, but because of a hold on canyon entries, due to high air borne contamination, sampling has been delayed. Decontamination work in the B Plant canyon is

sampling will be postponed for at least two weeks. Mr. Wooley inquired about the status of the 222S lab response regarding the inconsistency with the procedure used to analyze for Sr-90. Mr. Dave Evans (RL) stated the response will be released tomorrow, October 24, 1997, or at the latest, Monday, October 27, 1997.

Other Items

- Mr. Wooley was asked to check the status of the Notice of Construction (NOC) for Project W-059 and the Low Level Liquid Waste System, presented to Cindy Grant, WDOH Representative, for review.
- Mr. LeBaron provided a copy of the B Plant Emergency Plan to Mr. Wooley in response to his request in another meeting.
- Mr. Wooley inquired about the current status of the revision to the B Plant Waste Analysis Plan (WAP). Because responsibility for this task has been reassigned, progress has been slow. Mr. LeBaron reported that a draft is expected to be ready this week for internal review. Mr. Wooley suggested Mr. Anthony Miskho (FDH) be contacted to ensure that guidelines from a recently published guidance document for preparation of WAPs are included as appropriate in the B-Plant WAP.
- Mr. LeBaron reported he is working on a proposal for closure of the two organic tanks. The tank that was not used will require an administrative closure only. The second tank, used to store the organic, will require closure; it was suggested that the residual liquids be adsorbed and then cleaned using an LDR treatment standard such as steam cleaning. The steam cleaning method is more acceptable and applicable because it will minimize waste and optimize the use of resources. Mr. Wooley suggested all informational documentation (radiological surveys, etc.) for the pad site be collected to support the closure activity (PMM-BP-97-15).
- Mr. LeBaron proposed the daily inspections of the empty, isolated organic vessels be discontinued. Mr. Wooley agreed there is no reason to continue with the inspections. Mr. LeBaron will convey this message to the appropriate personnel.
- Mr. Wooley inquired about an inventory of the waste being left in B Plant Canyon. The inventory would document reasons for leaving the waste and how it will be managed.
