Re: Draft State Waste Discharge Permit ST4510

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) has developed a draft permit and fact sheet that is based on your *State Waste Discharge Permit Application for Storm Water Discharges to Land - Hanford Specific (98-EAP-445)*. Please review the enclosed draft permit and fact sheet. Factual comments that the U.S. Department of Energy (USDOE) would like to see considered by Ecology prior to the formal public comment period need to be submitted to Ecology by January 15, 1999. The permit issuance process will not be delayed if USDOE misses this date.

A 30-day public comment period for this draft permit and fact sheet is expected to begin around January 25, 1999. The public notice of draft permit will be made at that time in the Tri-City Herald and in a mailing to parties of record. The proposed permit conditions in the draft permit could be changed during the public review process.
