Dear Mr. Stewart:

During the meeting of April 19, 1991, it became clear that some of the data from our cooperative effort, which had been passed on to DOE or its contractors, had become misplaced. ANF has reconstructed the various transactions which involved transfer of data. A chronological listing of these events and data involved is attached.

Enclosure 1 reveals that data was transmitted to EPA and WHC before our agreement on cooperation.


Enclosure 2 contains two well sketches, one for 4" PVC and one for 6" steel. The 4" PVC wells no longer exist. I will discuss well information later.

Enclosure 8 discloses data from samples taken in 1987 but never acted upon. The quality of the data is suspect in that sampling and sample handling protocol was archaic. There is lack of correlation between the two sets of analyses.

To my knowledge this package contains the ANF response to all previous data requests. A request for additional details of well construction and well log data was discussed at the April 19 meeting. We have some additional data on some wells and have identified the driller for each of the wells. The drillers have agreed to furnish all data they have, but have not responded in a timely manner. We will attempt to complete this effort by May 10. If some drillers respond before others we may send what we have at that time.
