SUMMARY

7 Bill explained that the storage yard was not used to store waste, only chemicals. The chemicals were stored there and were to be used in waste simulation research. The chemicals remained at the location for a long time and expired or became obsolete containers weathered and integrity became poor allowing pin holes, leaks and weeps. If spills occurred they would be minor and were cleaned up. No sampling was performed. A RCRA part A permit application was submitted to allow treatment of the chemicals. Some containers were overpacked and much of the waste was mixed into a grout material and rendered non-regulated. Then it was shipped off-site. RCRA Closure plan submitted to Ecology. All waste was treated in containers on plastic. No spills occurred.
