REVISION 2 OF THE REMEDIAL INVESTIGATION (RI) PHASE 2 SUPPLEMENTAL WORK PLAN FOR THE HANFORD SITE, 1100-EM-1 OPERABLE UNIT (OU)

Copies of Revision 2 of the RI Phase 2 Supplemental Work Plan for the Hanford Site 1100-EM-1 OU (DOE/RL-90-37) are enclosed. This document replaces Revision 1, transmitted to you on September 30, 1991. The document revises items listed in our transmittal letter of Revision 1 requiring additional updates (delineation of work accomplished, documentation of all planned tasks required as a result of settlement of the 1100-EM-1 dispute). Additionally, it includes new appendices, most importantly Appendix B, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' (USACE) Quality Assurance Project Plan, which details the rationale for new USACE procedures for field and analytical services. Additionally, it incorporates a new Sampling and Analyses Plan which contains procedures for continuation of groundwater monitoring during the interim period between completion of RI sampling and initiation of any Remedial Action. Since the use of this data differs from that of the RI, the data quality objectives in the Plan differ from those of the RI.

The revised plan is being issued to you as draft. This is being done because the revision was made to better reflect changes needed as a result of the dispute settlement, to incorporate additional changes caused by the USACE's assumption of responsibility for 1100-EM-1, and to add additional information recently proposed regarding the post-RI groundwater monitoring - not to address regulatory comments on the work plan. Therefore, we request that you review the revised plan per review requirements of the Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order and provide any comments to Mr. R. K. Stewart, the Unit Manager for the U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Field Office. Most of the changes in this revision have been discussed with your respective Unit Managers.

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
