Dear Mr. Rasmussen:

This letter addresses the Hanford Facility Dangerous Waste Part A Permit Application, Form 3s for the Double Shell Tank (DST) System, and the 204-AR Waste Unloading Station.

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) has received and reviewed the U.S. Department of Energy's (USDOE) Part A Permit Application Revisions (Form 3s). The scope of the changes submitted include:

1. Replacing Fluor Daniel Hanford, Inc. (FDH) with Lockheed Martin Hanford Corporation (LMHC) as the co-operator of these units.
2. Modifying the 244-U Double Contained Receiver Tank Site Plan to show the correct location of 244-U.

These are the only two (2) modifications that are approved: Revision 9 of the Double-Shell Tank System Part A Permit (Form 3) and Revision 5 of the 204-AR Waste Unloading Station.
