Dear Mr. Wisness:

This letter addresses the U.S. Department of Energy's (USDOE) transmittal of the Hanford Facility Dangerous Waste Part A Permit Application, Form 1, and four (4) Part A, Form 3s, which have been revised to document the change in co-operator from Lockheed Martin Hanford Corporation (LMHC) to CH2M Hill Hanford Group (CHG) for four (4) treatment, storage, and disposal (TSD) units. The four (4) units are the Double-Shell Tank System, the Single-Shell Tank System, the 204-AR Waste Unloading Station, and the Grout Treatment Facility.

The scope of the change submitted is limited to replacing LMHC with CHG as Co-operator of these units. The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) accepts and approves these forms for the purpose of documenting a change in Co-operator only. Ecology's acceptance does not alter comments being evaluated as part of other regulatory reviews or negotiations (e.g., Double-Shell Tank Part B Permit Application review).
